

Upcoming Missions – Oct/Nov 2019

This coming fall H.E.L.P. will be setting up medical camps in the high elevation Mustang region of Nepal. We will be at approx. 9,000 feet upon arrival, into the city of Jomsom, where our journey will begin. From there the elevation ranges from 9,000 feet to 13,000 feet.

Our goal is to establish daily medical camps that would triage patients, many of which will be kids, and to aid in both diagnosing and treatment if possible. There will be some occasions where we may have to arrange for more severe cases be seen at the nearest health post.

We will also be looking at establishing some new relationships with the local clinics/health posts to determine if they are in need of obstetrics equipment and supplies like what we are supplying clinics in the Gorkha region of Nepal through our Baby Born Project.

I will be travelling this coming April to work with our team on the ground in Kathmandu. We are planning to visit the Terai area (southern Nepal) and the local clinics/health posts for our Baby Born Project.

We continue to get excited with all the successful infant deliveries occurring through the partnership clinics for our Baby Born Project.
